Options:

1. Purchase a bathrobe, slippers and toiletries for a woman at **My Sister's Place**. We are sponsoring 25 women and 5 men. Wendy Brooks is the point person.
2. Purchase slippers for boys and girls from the **CAP Center's Headstart Program**. We are sponsoring 27 girls and 25 boys. Melanie Rothman is the point person.
3. Purchase gifts for teens who live at **Pleasantville Cottages**, a residential school for emotionally troubled children. We are sponsoring one of the cottages (14 teenage girls). Ellen Blumstein is the point person.
4. Purchase gift cards for families in need who have children at **Mamaroneck Avenue School (MAS)**. We are sponsoring 10 families. You can drop your donations at MAS Monday through Friday between 8 am and 3 pm. You can leave with Dina Reynoso, the school social worker, or with the school greeter. Please put your gift cards in an envelope with your own name and address on the outside. If you are not able to drop there, please contact me.
5. Purchase gift cards for families in need who have children at **Central School**. We are sponsoring 10 families. You can drop your donations at Central School Monday through Friday between 8 am and 3 pm. You can leave with Suehay Gonzalez, the school social worker, or with the school greeter. Please put your gift cards in an envelope with your own name and address on the outside. If you are not able to drop there, please contact me.
